SHARING MEMORIES



On Monday morning at 9:00, I was sitting on my back porch, reading a book while enjoying a cup of coffee. I justify this by claiming to be a responsible citizen. There were 200 pages left to read and the book was due at the library the next day.

I noticed the haze over the city from all the fires elsewhere, but it seemed clear at my house. Weather reports told of temperatures over 110 degrees for many days in the southwest US, but there was a cool breeze ruffling the pages of my book. In the northeast, 7" of rain fell in less than an hour causing serious flooding. At my house the intermittent rain showers have caused a healthy lawn without extra watering. At my house, there was no loss of an infant. Believe me, I was especially aware of and grateful for my blessings and my location in this country
