Tennessee Soup (Instant Pot or Crockpot)

• Prep Time: 20 minutes

An easy dump and go beef and vegetable soup with a barbecue sauce boost! Make it fast in the Instant Pot or low and slow in the Crockpot.

Ingredients

- 3 carrots, peeled and sliced
- 2 ribs celery, sliced or diced
- 1 Tbsp dry minced onion
- 2 cups water
- 1 Tbsp Better than Bouillon Beef Base
- 1 (14.5 oz) can diced tomatoes
- 1/2 tsp black pepper
- 1 tsp garlic powder
- 1 1/2 tsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1/3 cup barbecue sauce
- 1 pound beef stew meat
- 1 Tbsp olive oil
- 1/4 cup flour
- 1/2 tsp kosher salt
- 1/8 tsp smoked paprika
- 2 cups frozen hashbrowns
- Shredded cheddar, for topping

Slow Cooker Instructions:

Slow Cooker Instructions:

- 1. Add carrots, celery, onion, water, bouillon, tomatoes, pepper, garlic powder, Worcestershire sauce and barbecue sauce into slow cooker. Stir.
- 2. In a Ziploc bag or a container with a lid add the beef, oil, salt, paprika and flour. Close the container and shake until beef is coated well. Stir the beef into the slow cooker.
- 3. Cover and cook on low for 6 hours.
- 4. Stir in the hashbrowns until warmed through.

 Ladle into bowls and top each serving with a bit of shredded cheese. Eat and enjoy!
